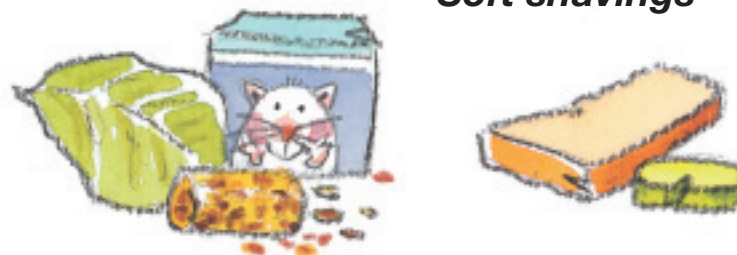
Its own things

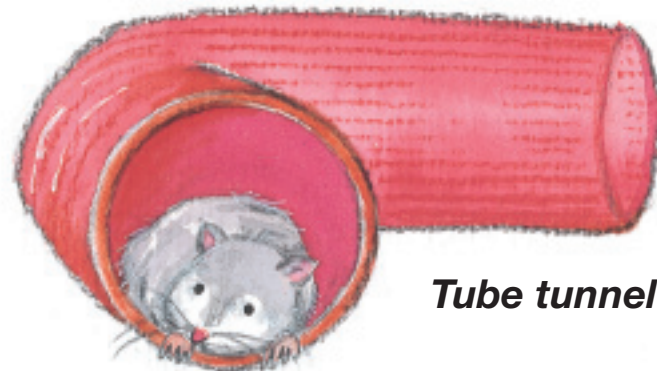

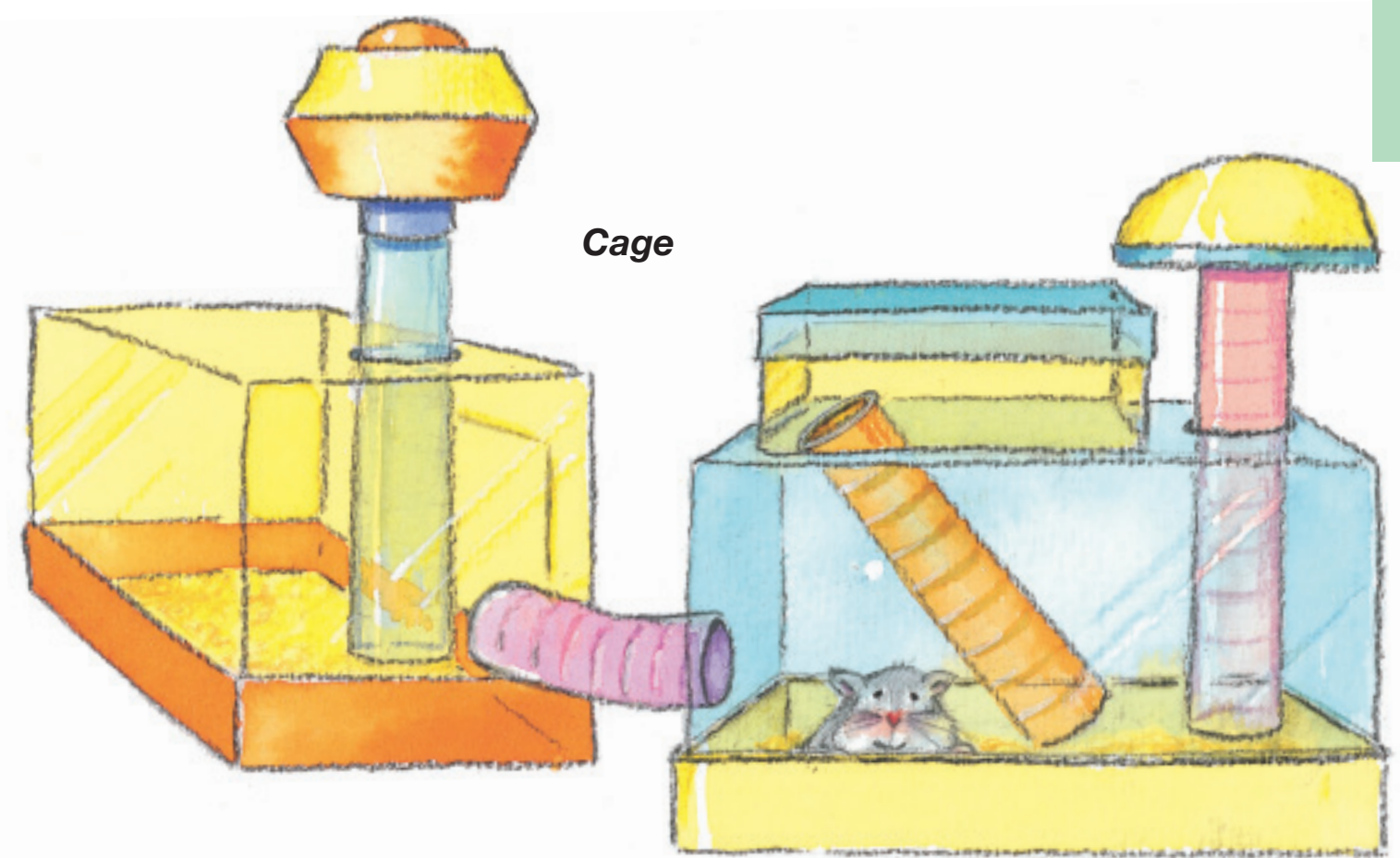

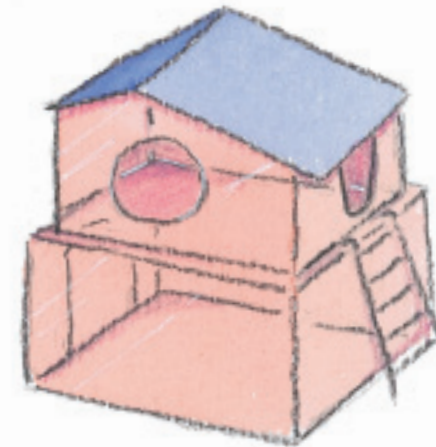
Tube tunnel

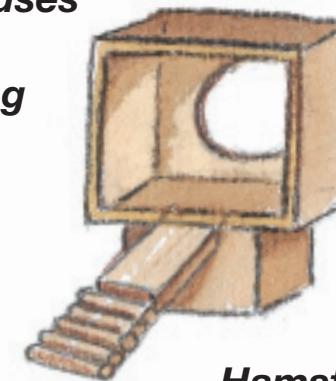
