

“Colored glass. How beautiful they are!”

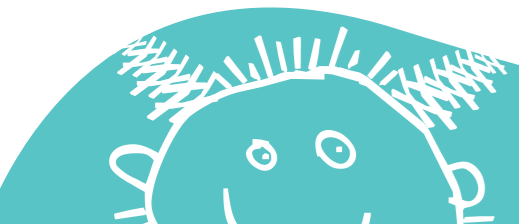
“They are no good to us now. If you like, I will give them to you.”
