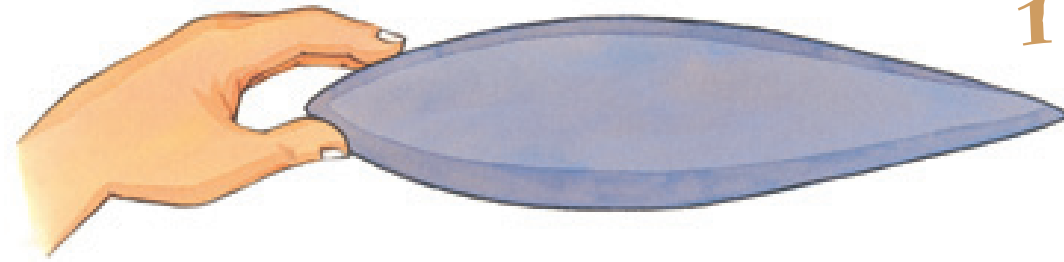
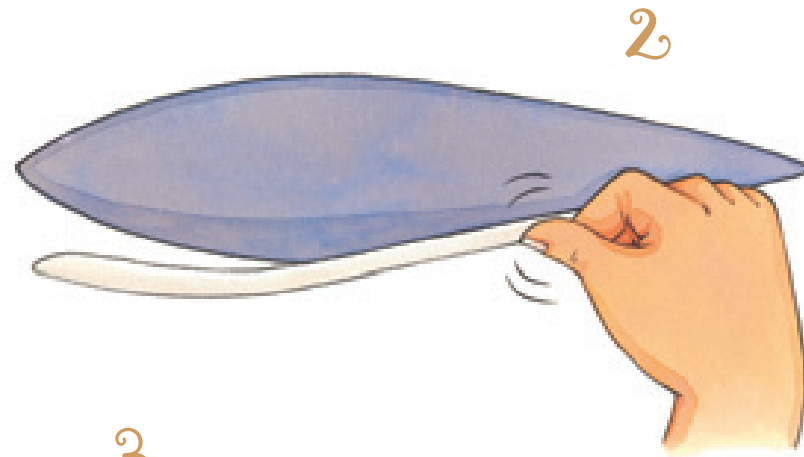


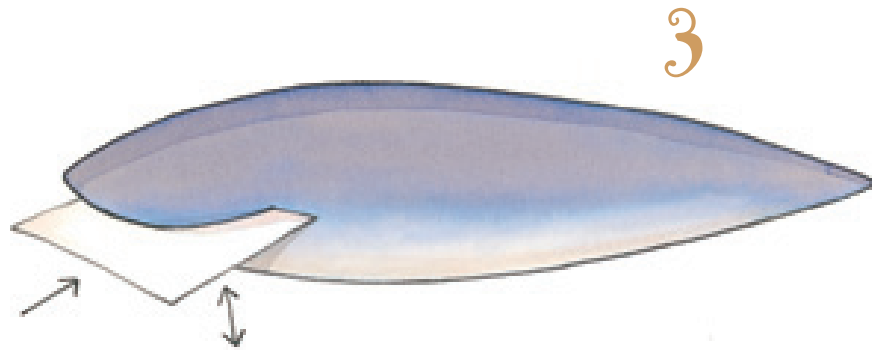
# Shark



1. Make a sausage pointed at one end and flat at the other.

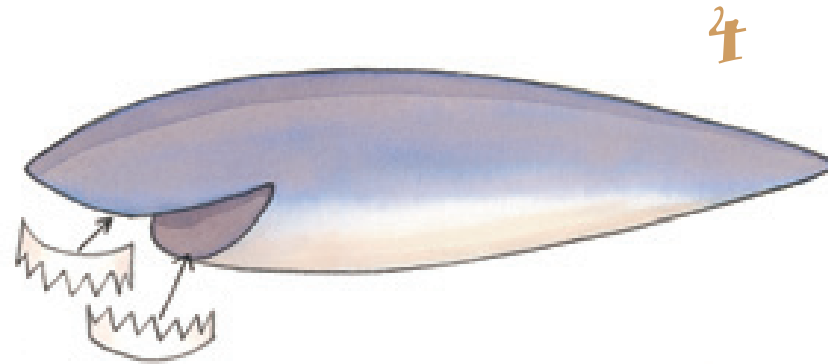


2. Flatten another white sausage on the lower part to color the belly. Smooth it out and blend it as best you can.

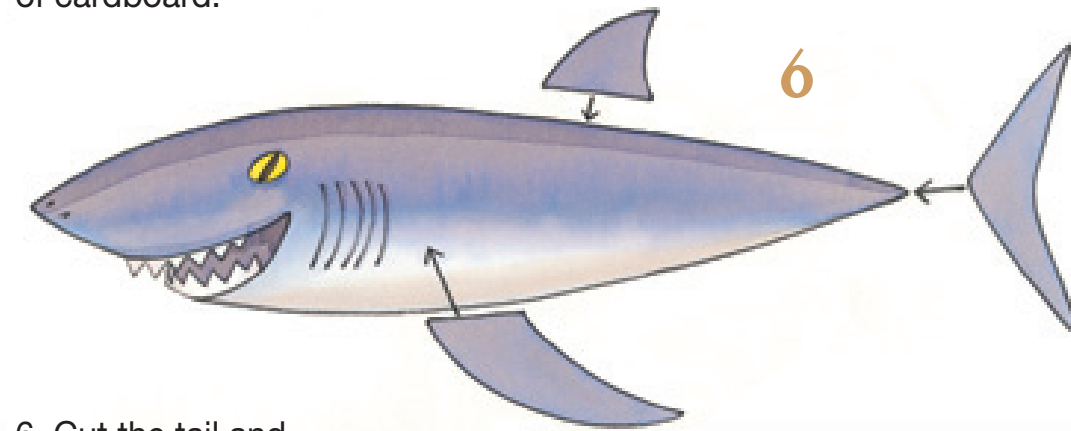
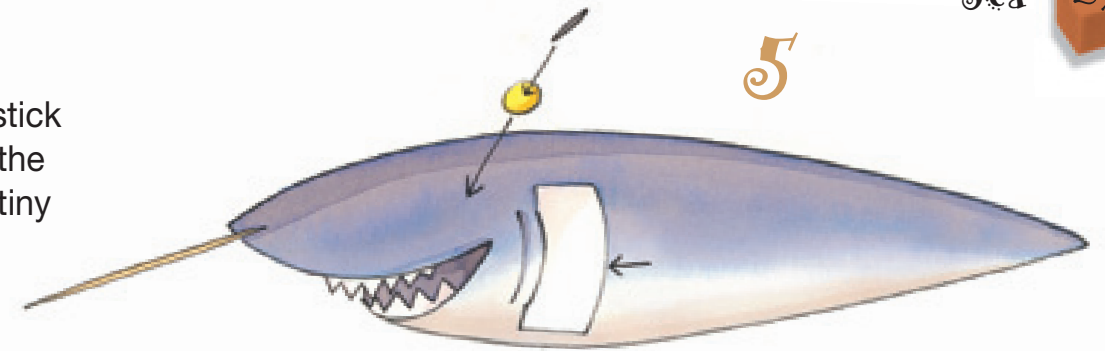


3. Open the mouth wide by placing a piece of cardboard inside and moving it up and down.

4. Cut some teeth out from a piece of white cardboard and stick them into the mouth opening.



5. To make the eyes, stick two yellow balls onto the shark and flatten two tiny black sausages onto them for the pupils. Make two holes with a toothpick for the nostrils. Mark five lines on each side of the shark with a piece of cardboard.



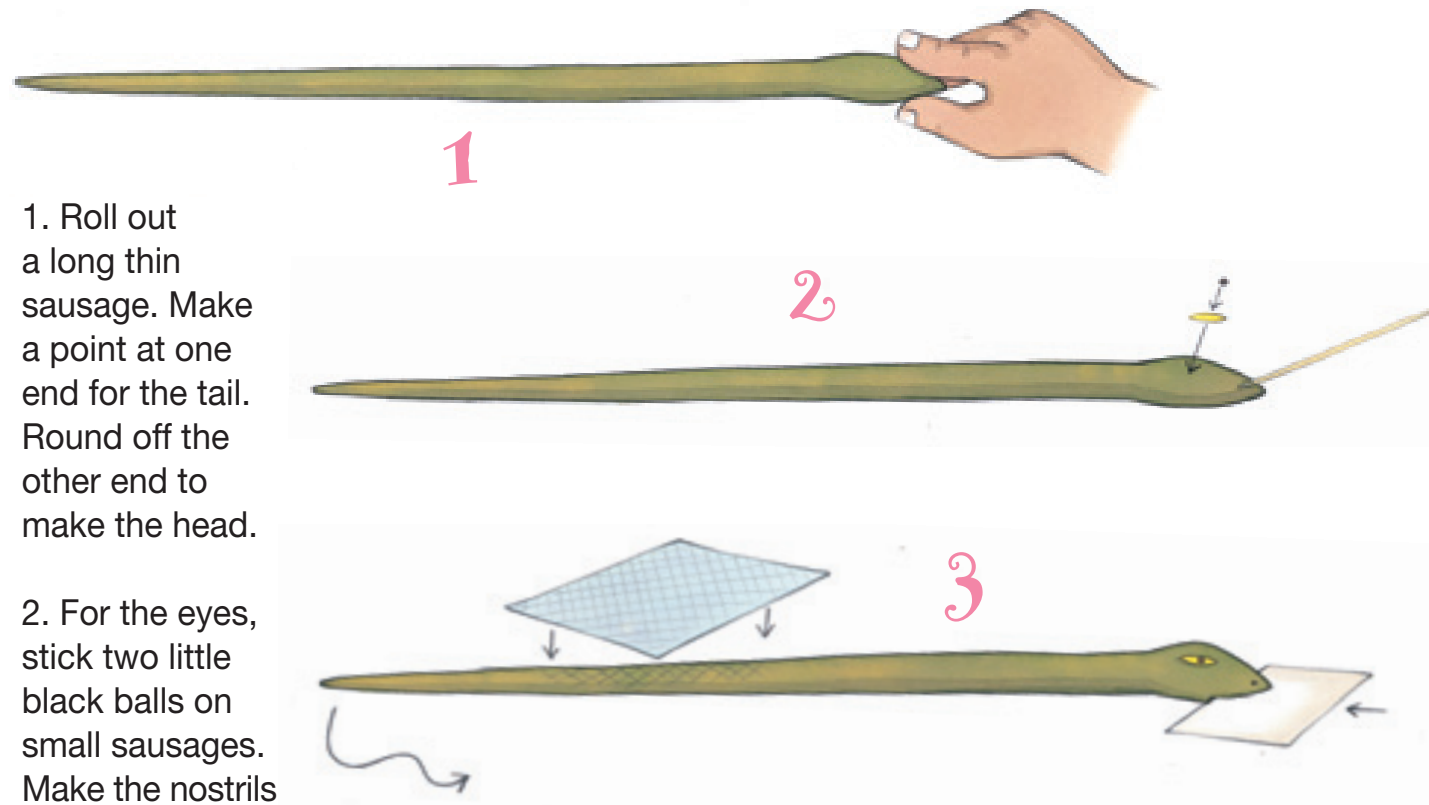
6. Cut the tail and fins out from a piece of cardboard. Stick them in place securely.



## Other species

By changing the shape of the head, you can make a ferocious hammerhead. Why not give it a try?

# Snake



1. Roll out a long thin sausage. Make a point at one end for the tail. Round off the other end to make the head.

2. For the eyes, stick two little black balls on small sausages. Make the nostrils with a toothpick.

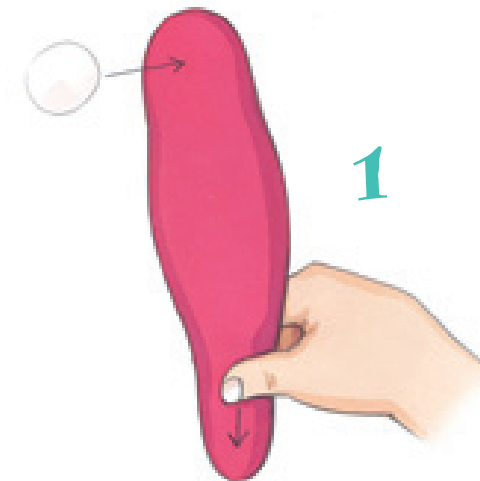
3. Open the mouth with a piece of cardboard. Then press a piece of mesh over the body for the scales. Lastly, bend it into an S-shape.

## Colorful snakes

There are many different types of snakes, with very different colors and markings. Instead of the texture, you could make colored patches.



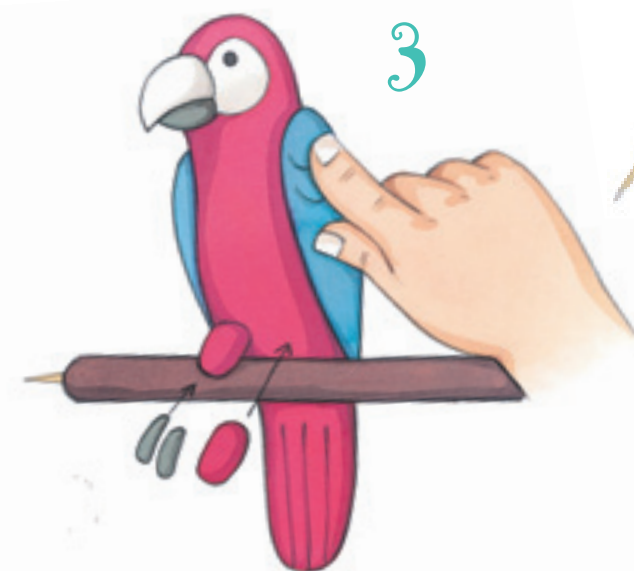
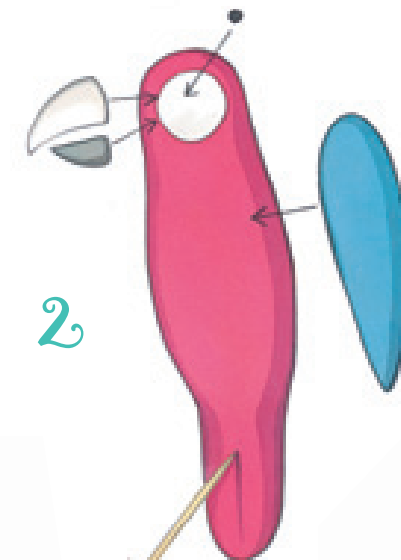
# Parrot



1. Make a sausage and mold the head and tail shapes, narrowing the tail. Flatten a different colored ball on each side of the head.

2. Stick on two black balls for the eyes. You can make the beak with two different sized sausages, curved and narrowed at the ends. Flatten and narrow two sausages for the wings. Mark the tail feathers with a toothpick.

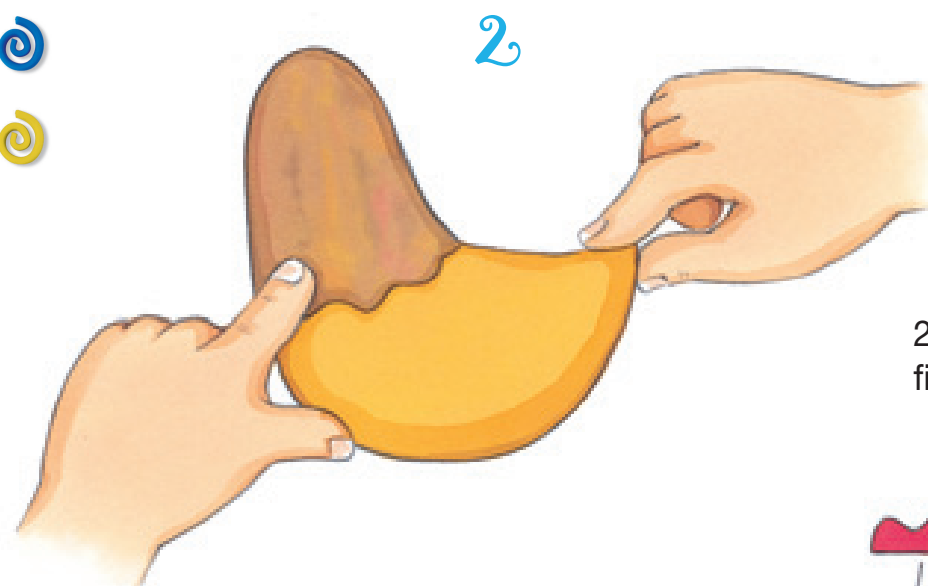
3. Use your fingers to create the wing texture. Place your parrot on a modeling clay branch and give it some claws made from small sausages.



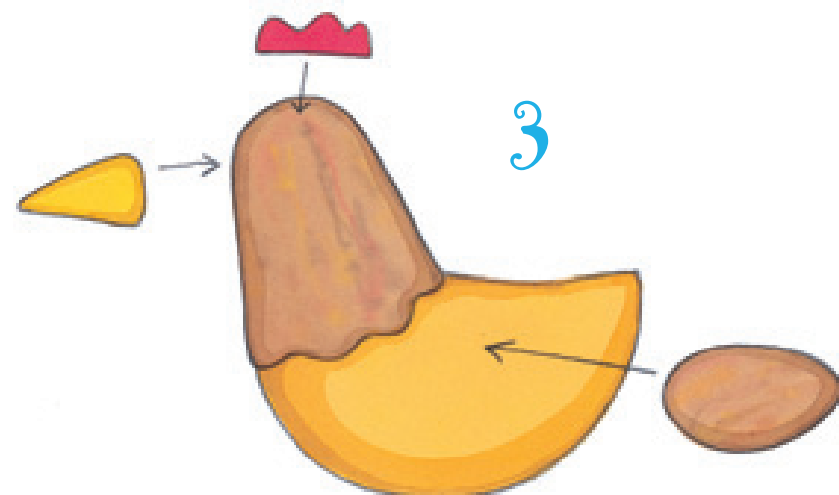


# Hen

1. Make a sausage rounded at the top and flat at the bottom. Join it to a half ball molded into a moon-shape with a toothpick.

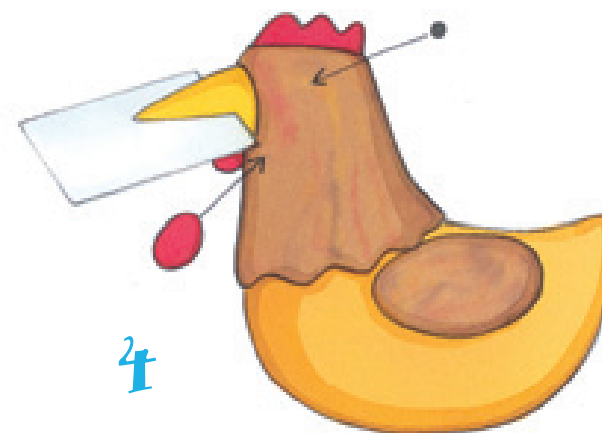
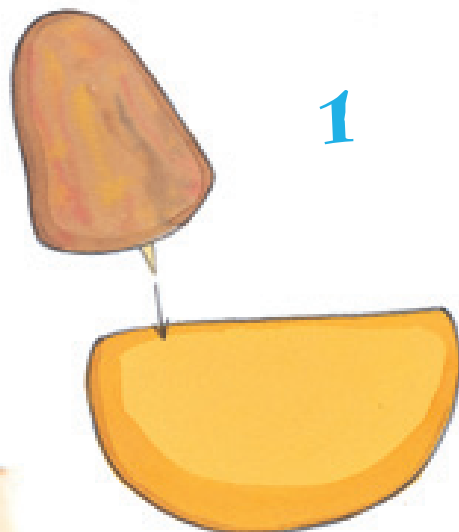


2. Secure the join with your fingers. Mold the tip of the tail.



3. Stick on a small cone for the beak. Use two flat modeling clay ovals for the wings. Cut out a cardboard crest and stick it into the head.

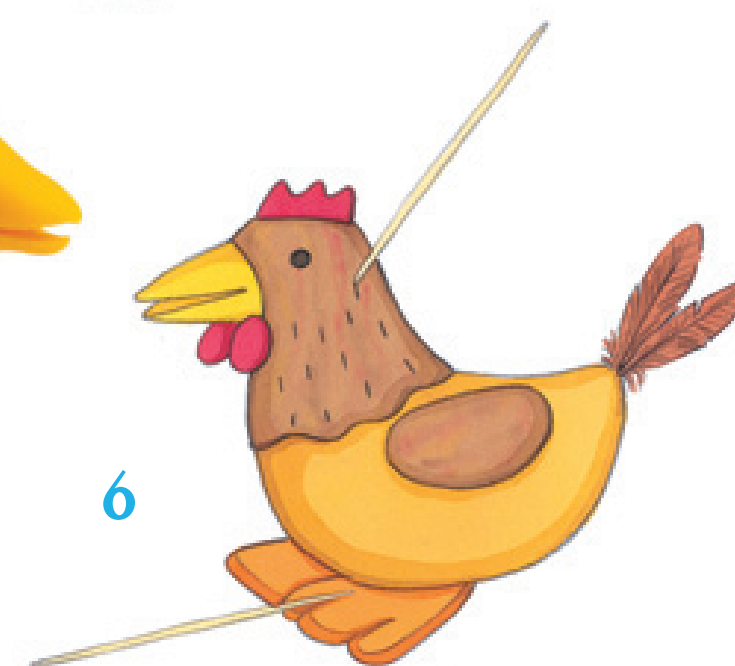
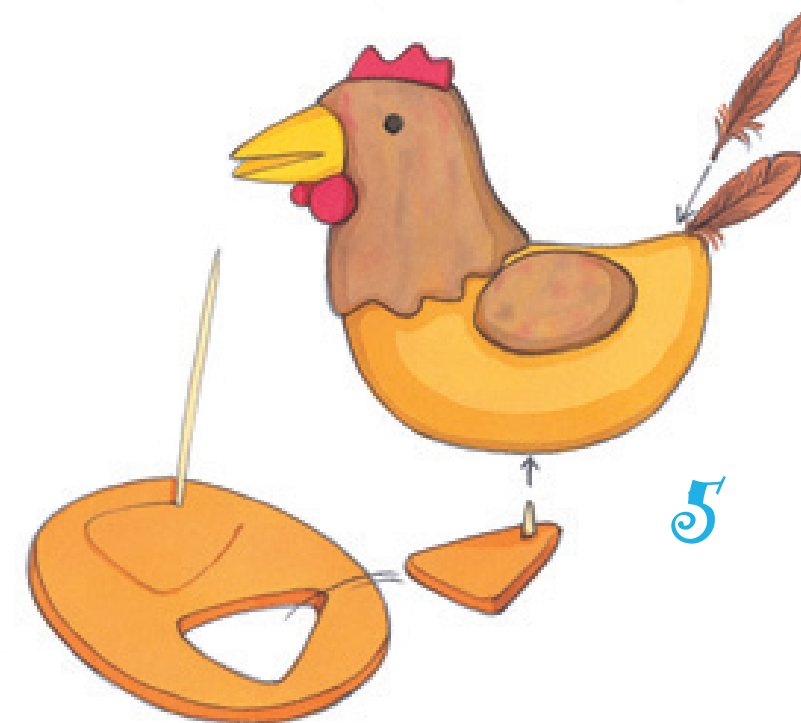
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4. Open the mouth with a piece of card. Stick two red balls underneath the beak for the jowl. Use two small black balls for the eyes.

5. To make the legs, cut out two triangles from a sheet of modeling clay and stick them into the body with the help of toothpicks. Also stick some feathers in the tail.

6. To finish off, use a toothpick to mark the toes on the feet and the feather texture.

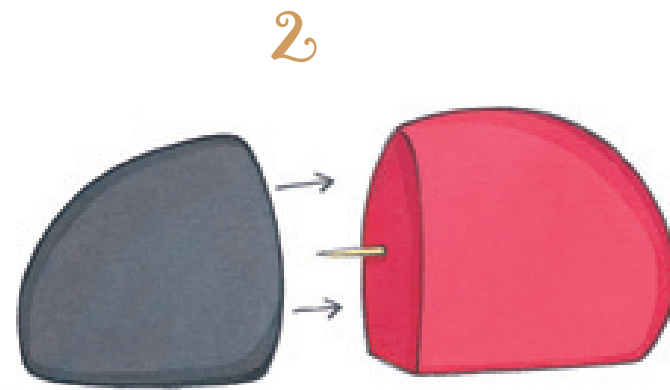
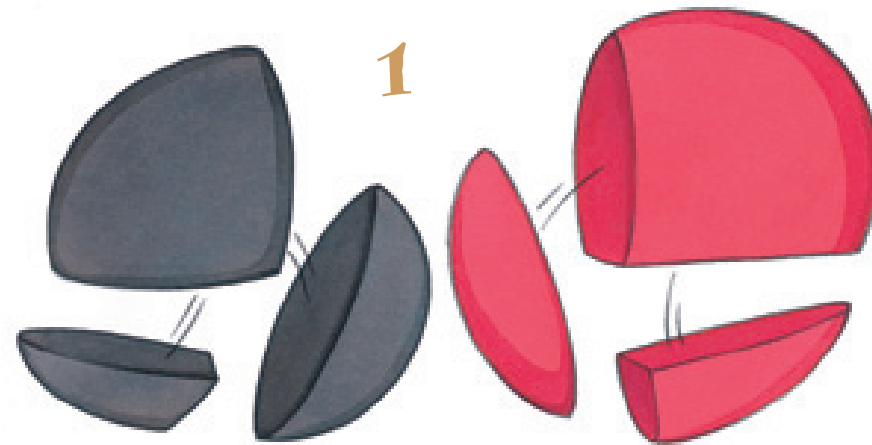






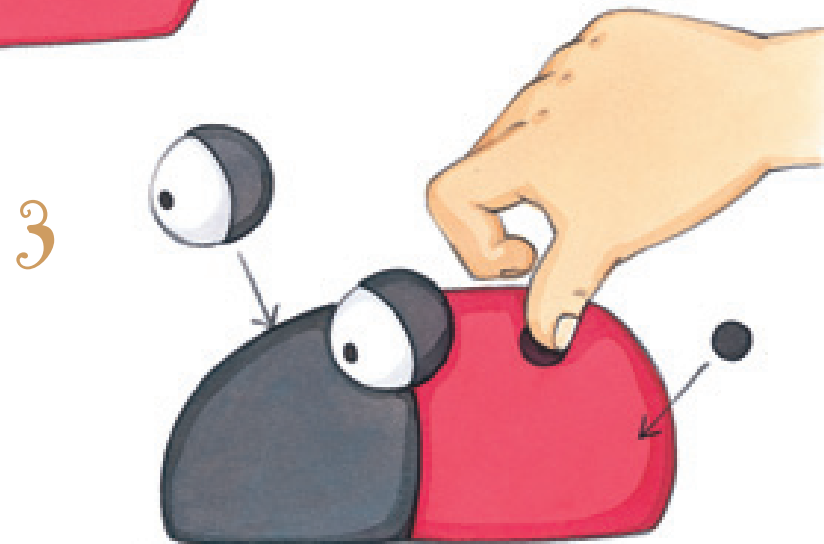
# Ladybird

1. Make two balls, one red and the other black. Cut off the bases and sides of the balls, as shown in the picture.



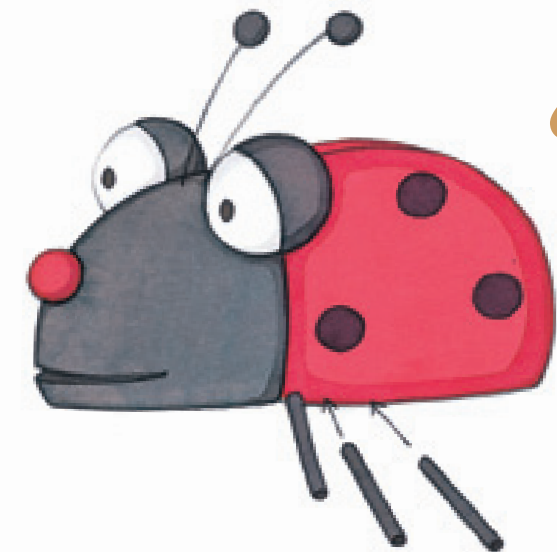
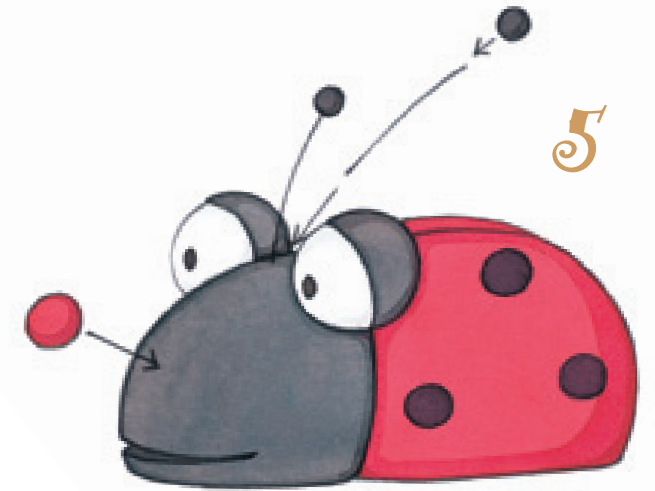
2. Join the two pieces together with a piece of toothpick.

3. Make some eyes and stick them onto the head. Flatten some black balls to cover the body with spots.



4. Use a toothpick to mark a line along the middle of its back. Open its mouth with a piece of cardboard.

5. A little ball will make the nose. Make the antennae from two pieces of fishing line with little balls at the ends.



6. Cut out six pieces of plastic tube for the legs and stick three into each side. If your ladybird is vain, you can make some eyelashes from small strips of cardboard.
