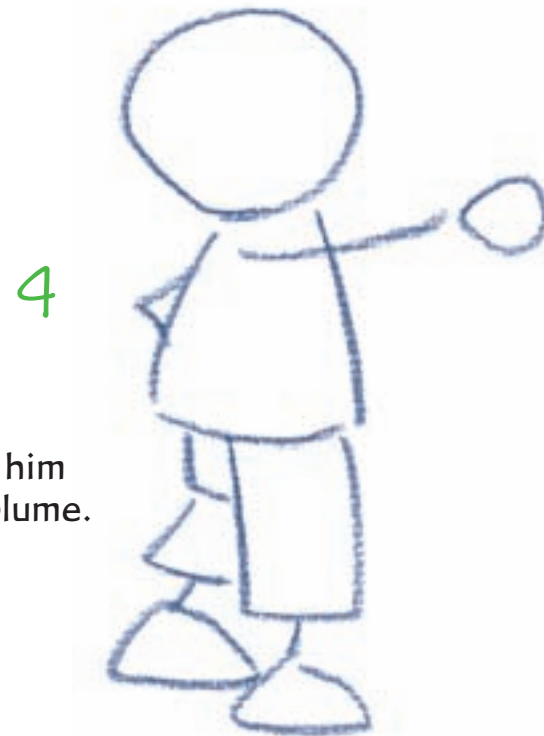

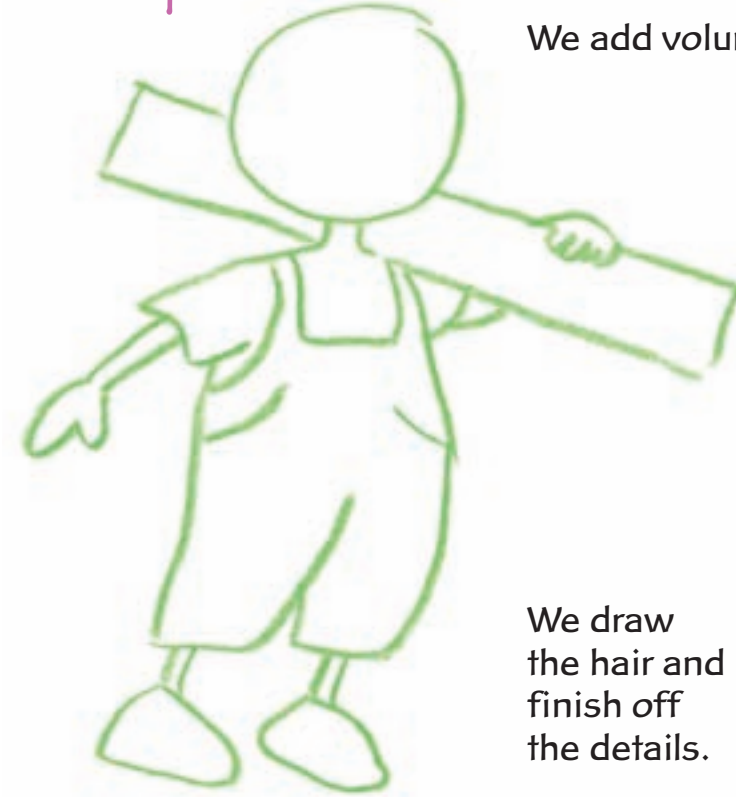
We draw the trousers and the pockets.
