

Now we are going to print with cork bungs. But before you start, do some tests on white paper to find out how much paint you should put on the cork for printing.

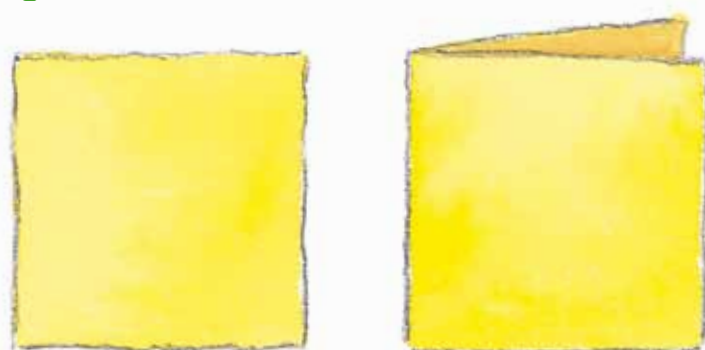


MATERIAL

- Yellow card
- Different sized cork bungs
- Green paint
- Paintbrush
- Black, red and green felt tipped pens
- Two binders
- Scissors
- Glue

Shall we print a caterpillar?

1 Cut out a square of yellow card, or if you prefer, a rectangle folded in half: Then you will be able to write the message inside the card.

2 Paint one side of a large cork green.

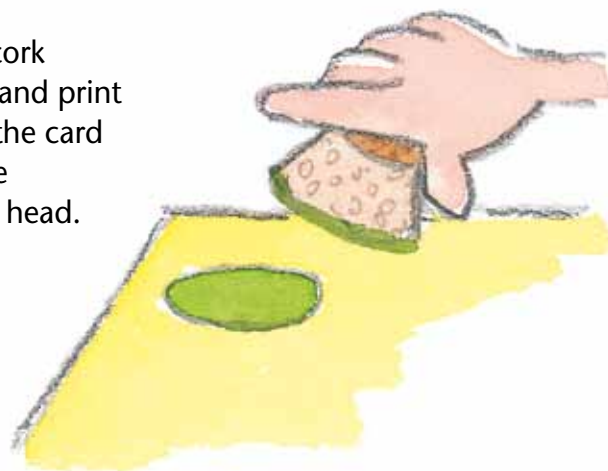

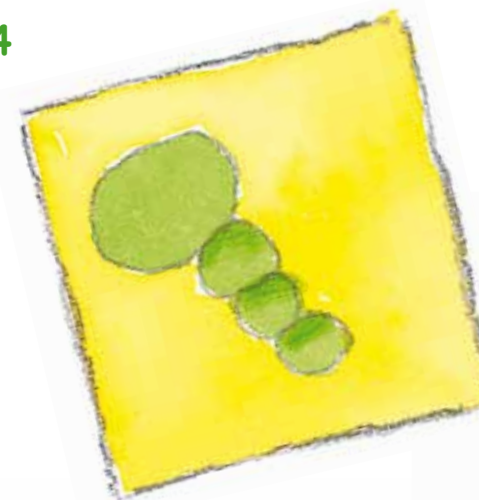
3 Use the cork as a stamp and print a circle on the card to make the caterpillar's head.

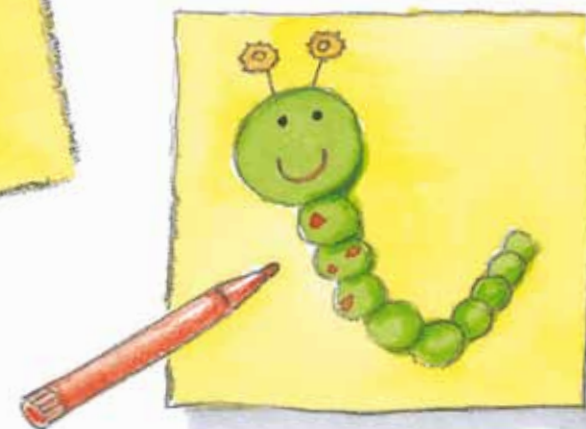


4 Then print some circles with the medium sized cork to make the body. Finally, print the tail with the smallest cork.

5 Draw the eyes with the black pen and the mouth with the red pen. Glue the binders in place for the antennae and join them to the head with black stripes. To finish, add some red spots on the body.

If you prefer, place some stickers instead of the binders. Oh! Don't forget to draw the grass!



MATERIAL

- Light brown, blue, green, red and black card
- Printed paper
- Black pencil
- Scissors
- Glue

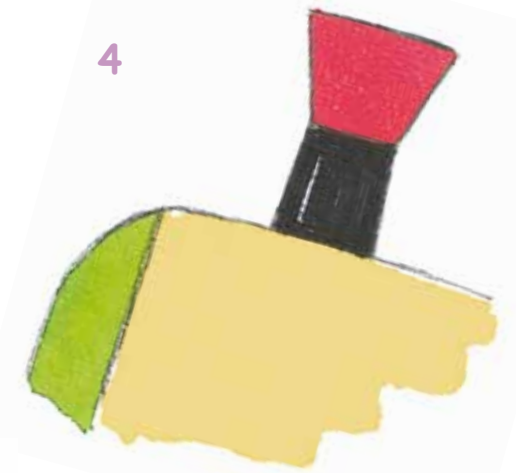
1 Copy the outline of the train onto the brown card (p. 33) and cut it out.

2 Draw the windows on the glossy orange card and cut them out. Make the upper part of the windows from the printed paper. Glue each thing in place.

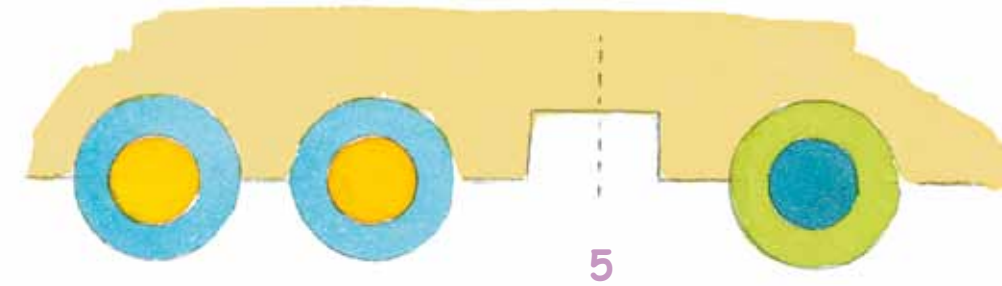
3 Cut out the bottom part of the funnel from black card and the top part from red card. You must glue them behind the locomotive.

4 Cut out a semi-circle of green glossy paper and glue it on the front of the train.

5 Cut out three large circles, two in blue and one in green (p. 33). Glue different colored smaller circles on top of them.



Glue all the wheels at the same height so that when you make a fold between the engine and the carriage, the train will stand up.



Despite the fact that dinosaurs have been extinct since long ago, many children love them!

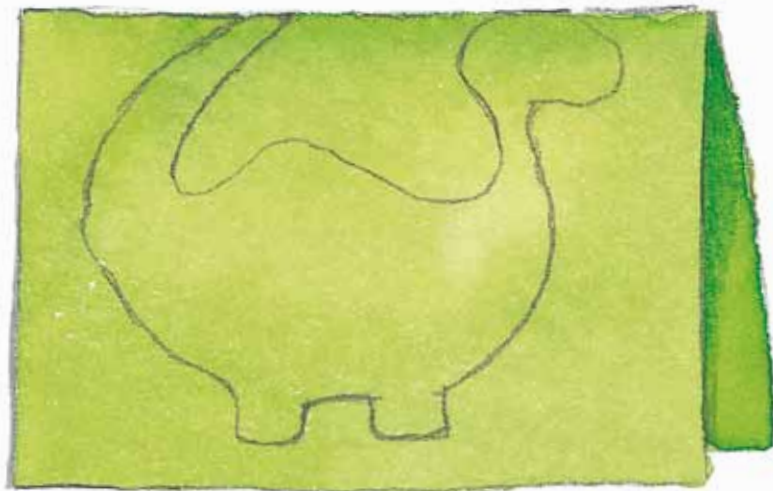
The dinosaurs are back!



MATERIAL

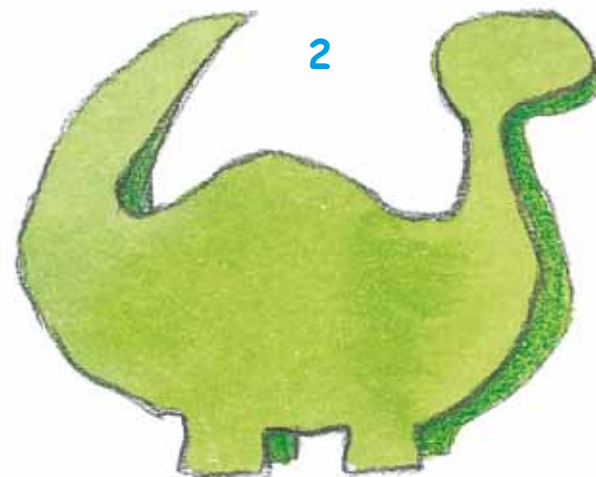
- Green card
- Pink tissue paper
- Black felt tipped pen
- Scissors
- Glue

1 Fold the card in half and draw the outline of the dinosaur on it (p. 33). The head and tail must coincide with the fold (look at the drawing).

2 Cut out the dinosaur on both sides being careful to leave the head and tail joined.



3 Make some little balls of tissue paper and glue them on the body.

4 Draw the eye, mouth, nose and claws on the feet with a black pen.

You can also glue on some plastic eyes, which you can buy. It might look more amusing!
