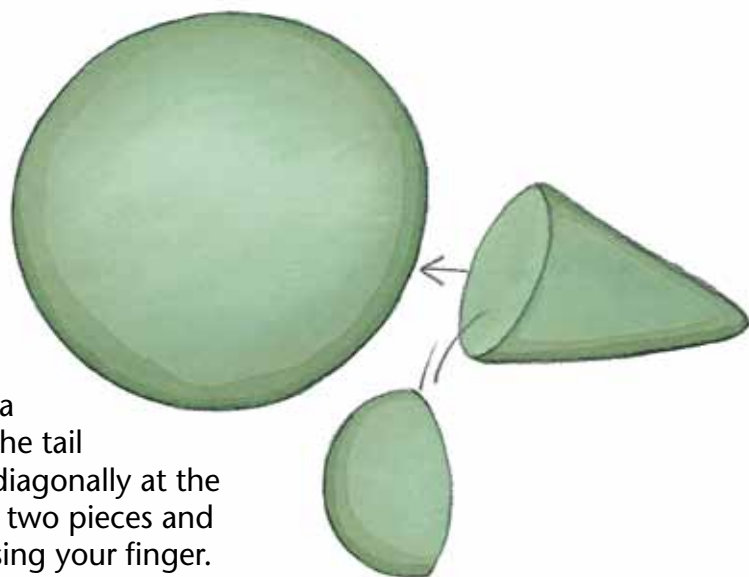




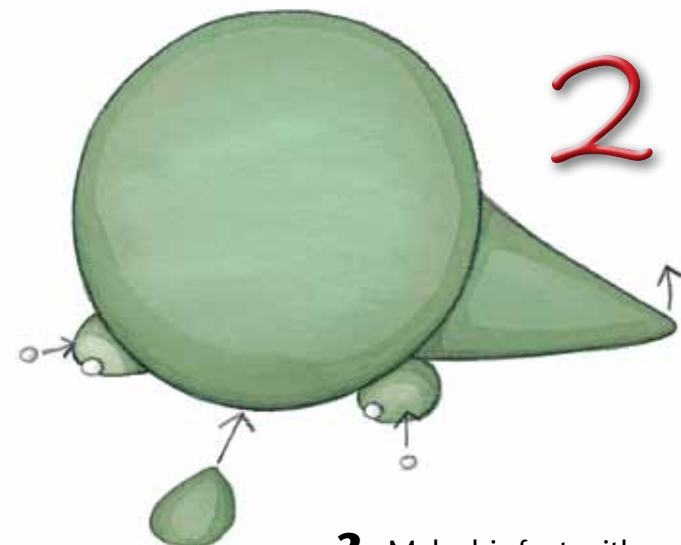

1. Make a round ball for the body. Mold a drop shape for the tail and then cut it diagonally at the fat end. Join the two pieces and smooth them using your finger.



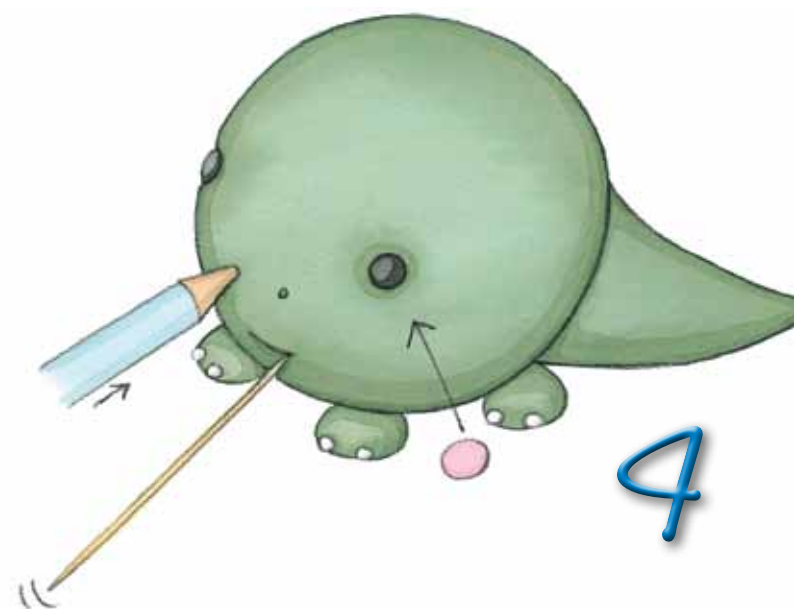
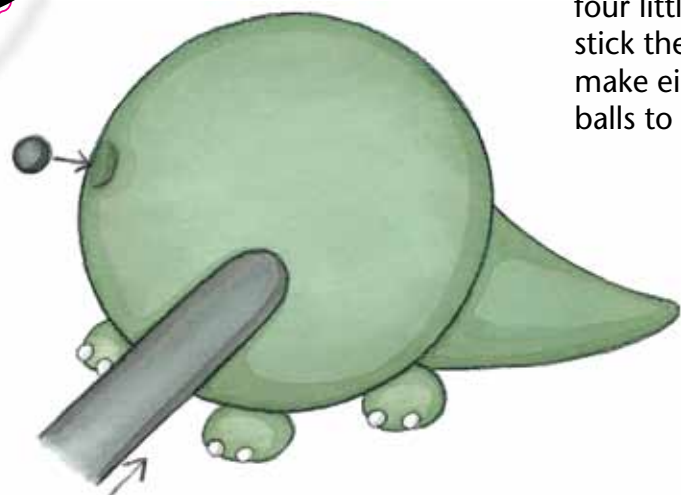

2. Make his feet with four little drops. After you stick them onto the body, make eight tiny white balls to create his hoofs.

3. Use the eraser side of a pencil to make two indentations at eye level. Stick a little black ball into each depression.

5. Now you just need to sculpt little triangles to make the scales on his back. They'd be nice in another color. Stick the long side of each triangle onto his back, one behind the other.

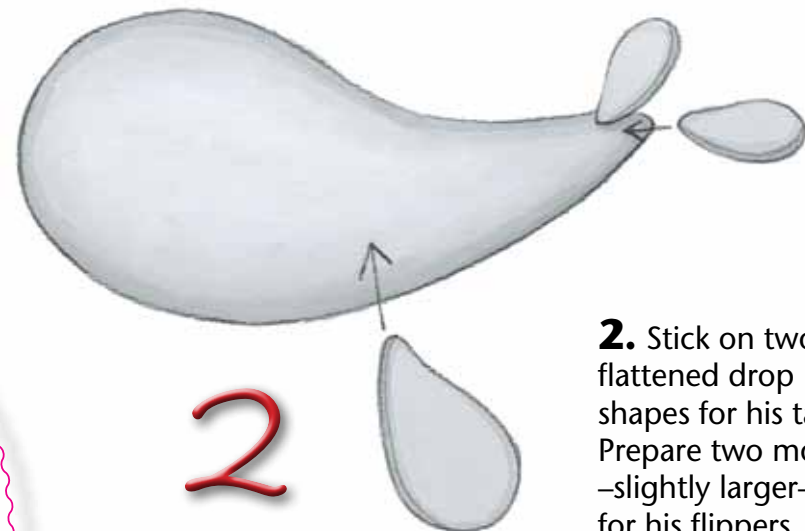

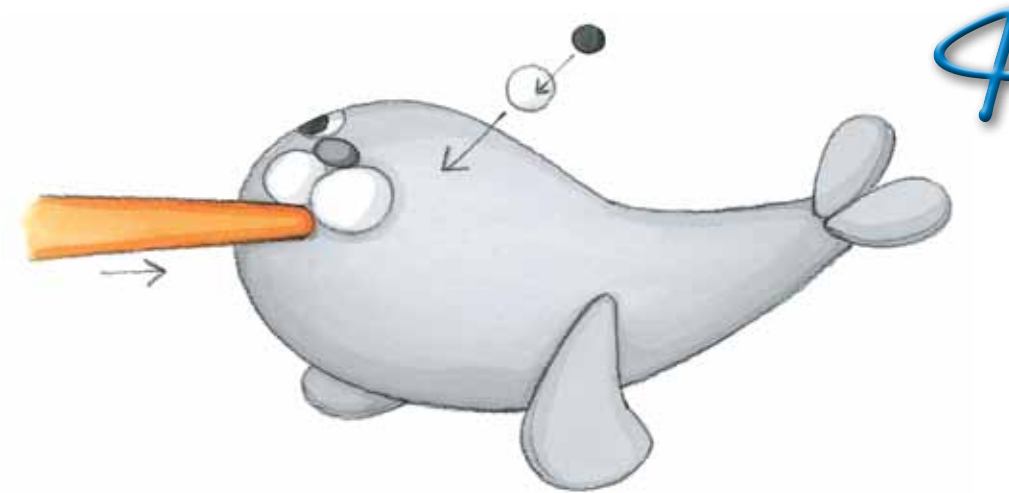
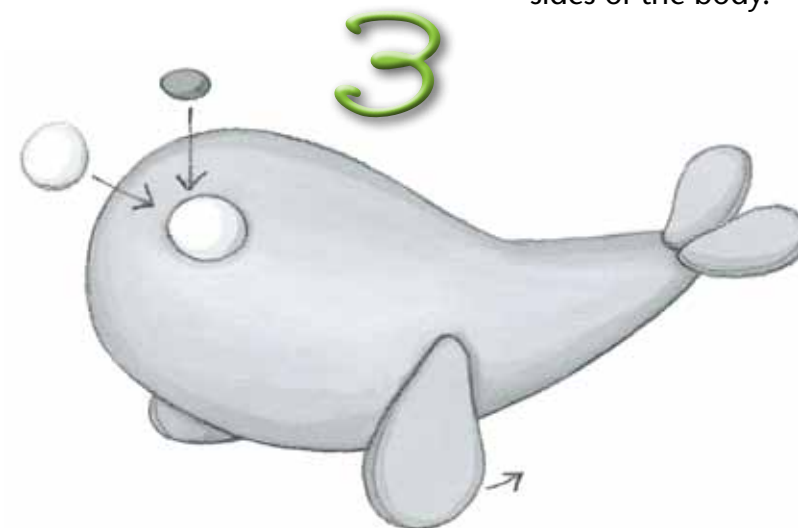
3. Flatten his two flippers so they will hold up the body, with his head raised slightly. Two little white balls and an even smaller black one will be his snout.



1. Form a long drop shape with plasteline and raise the thick end a bit.

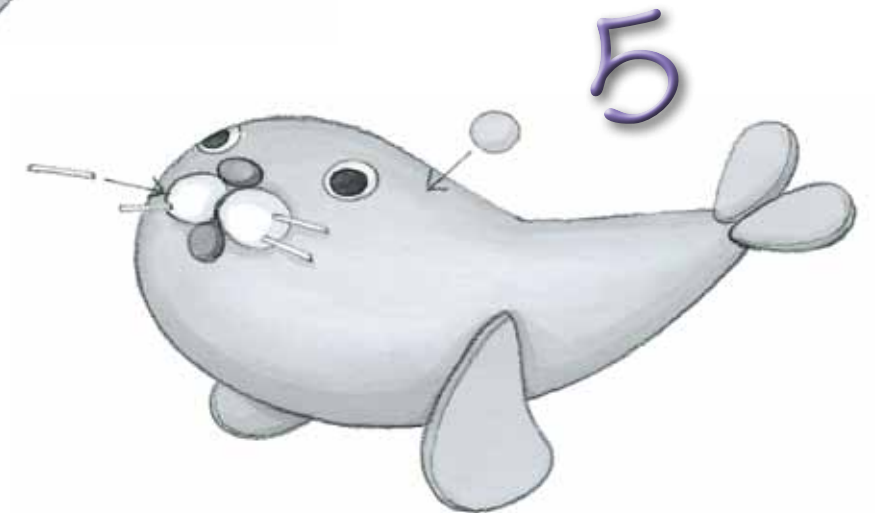


2. Stick on two flattened drop shapes for his tail. Prepare two more –slightly larger– for his flippers. Stick the narrow end onto both sides of the body.



4. Make a hole for his mouth using the handle end of a paintbrush. Now make two small white disks and even smaller black ones for his eyes. Make sure they're nice and flat.

5. Make two little flat grey balls for his ears. Smoosh them a bit when sticking them onto his head. You can cut up a bag tie or a little piece of fishing wire to make his whiskers. Seals are so cute!

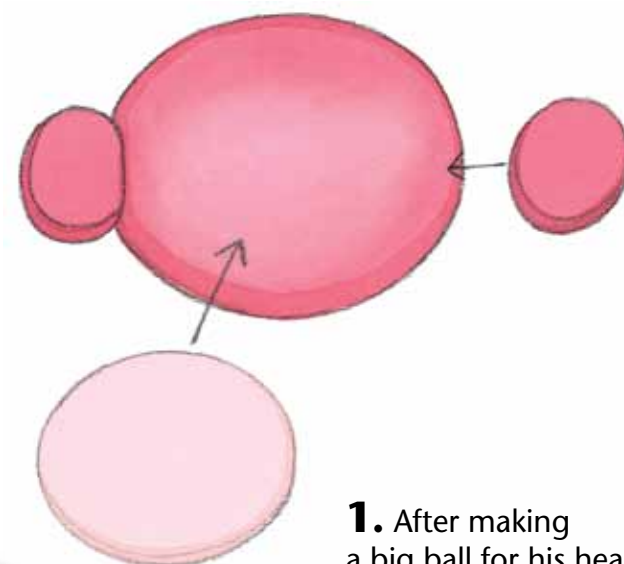

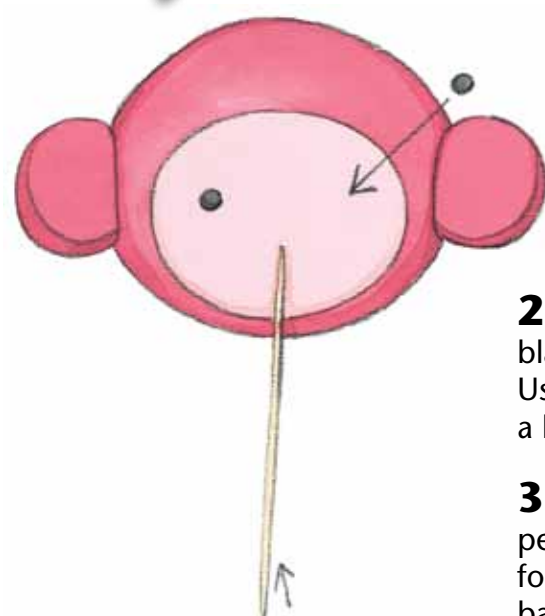
1. After making a big ball for his head, stick on a flat disk in a light color for his face. Then stick on two flat disks on each side of the head: he's got ears now!

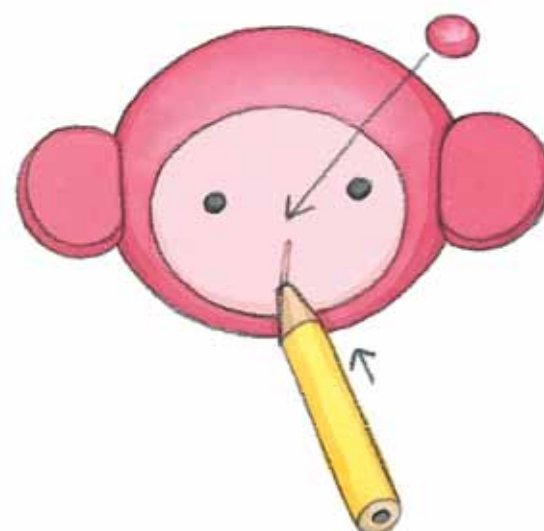

2. And stick two little black balls on for the eyes. Use a toothpick to draw a line to make the snout.

4. Mold a thick barrel shape for his body. Join it to the head and flatten it slightly onto the table so he sits up.

5. Now roll out a long thin snake. Cut it into several pieces: two pieces for the front arms, two longer pieces for the back legs –bending them at his knees– and the longest piece for his tail.
