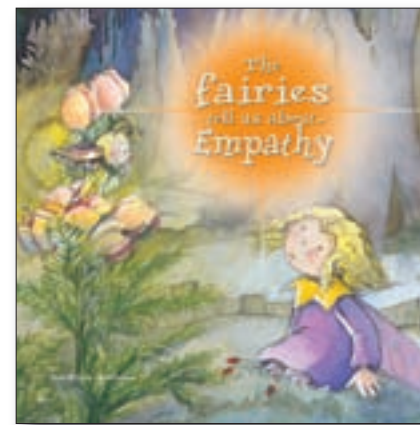


The fairies tell us about...

Live and learn

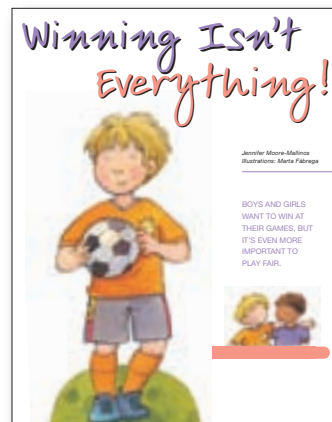
Books in the *Live and Learn* series take a child's point of view and especially the view of children who either suffer from some physical challenge or lack self-confidence in going about their everyday activities. They encourage kids never to be afraid of a challenge. Following each story are four pages of suggested activities that relate to the book's theme. A final two-page section offers advice to parents.



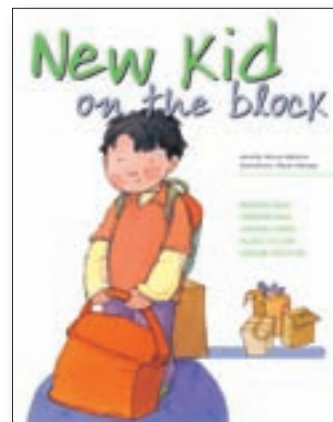
A child's desire to be like the other kids and just have fun is put to the test. But first he needs to learn how to become independently mobile while being confined to a wheelchair before he can focus on mastering an activity such as basketball.



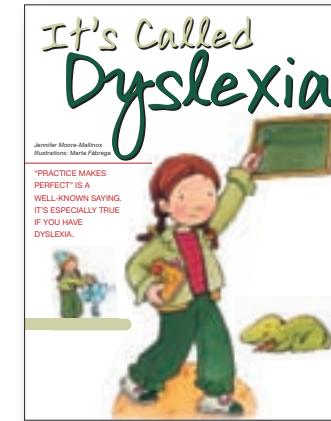
Some of the realities of being a kid are explored through the eyes of a child. At first it seems that being a kid is a tough job and that grown-ups have it easy but after careful consideration, one realizes that being a kid isn't so bad after all and that becoming a grown-up can wait!



This story's little boy plays on a football team. When they forget to play fair, a boy on the opposing team is injured. They feel badly about the accident and come to realize that being a good sport is more important than winning.



This is a story that many children can relate to. It is about a child and his family who go through the emotional experience of moving. Although saying goodbye to a home and old friends can be difficult, making new friends and having a new place to live can be exciting.



The child in this story knows the alphabet, but she sometimes has trouble putting all the letters together to read words. No matter how hard she tries, she often mixes up the letters or writes them backwards. She's unhappy until her teacher explains that she has dyslexia, and that with special help she will overcome her reading problem.



Lana is 10 years old and she's deaf. Throughout the story, Lana discusses what it is like to be deaf and some of the things that she uses to help her learn at school and to communicate with others. Although Lana uses a hearing aid, she can't always hear everything clearly but it doesn't stop her from being a child.

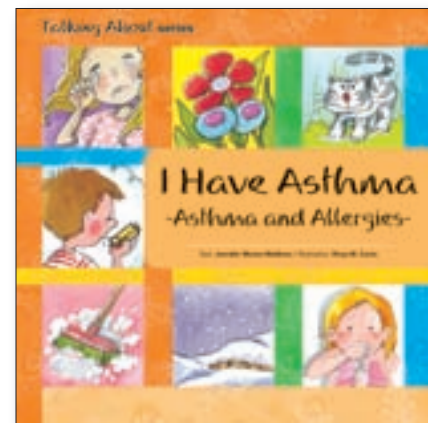


Talking about...

Jesus enters Jerusalem
Matthew 21:5
 Tell the city of Zion: 'Look, your king is coming to you in all simplicity and humility, riding on a donkey!'

When Jesus entered Jerusalem, people welcomed him with palm and olive branches. It is not usual for a king to ride on a donkey; normally he would have been riding in a carriage. However, this king is special. This king is the king of peace. This king came and lived among us. He had no special privileges.

Children sometimes say:
 - Do you have to be poor to be humble?
 - No, humble people are people who aren't always drawing attention to themselves.

A few minutes to think:
 Sometimes, when children are proud, they are impressed by important people's position, or by material possessions. Children need to learn that, even if people have important jobs, or many possessions, that does not mean that they are better than others. We all rely on other people - no matter who we are - help the children to notice the virtue of humility in the people they know: teachers and relatives, in current events, in film or in traditional tales (see the story of Cinderella on page 15).

Jesus enters Jerusalem
 When the people heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, they collected palm branches and went out to greet him. Many people laid their coats on the road while others cut branches from trees to make a carpet on the ground. The crowd shouted:
 • Hosanna to the son of David!
 • Hosanna to the highest!
 • Hosanna! Welcome to the one who comes in the name of the Lord, Hosanna!

This week...
 I will think how we all need help - even the people we think are important.

Carpet made of flowers
Matthew 21:8
 Jesus went to the temple, an olive branch would be green. The background might be made of green leaves or yellow flowers.

Children sometimes say:
 - Some children laugh at me today calling me small and skinny but I didn't pay any attention to them.
What do we answer?
 Well done. They only want you to get cross. If you are patient, they will learn you name, but if you argue with them, they will just keep bothering you.

A few minutes to think:
 It is hard to know what to say to a child in this situation. The wonder if the child was being patient or if he had just become resigned to being treated like that. Patience is an active virtue. It requires an effort. It is not being passive. We must help our children to be patient.

Let's go fishing
Matthew 13:19
 Blessed are those who sow the seed in good soil. They will bring forth a crop of wheat, barley, wheat, and other grain.

Material:
 Biscuits, water, wooden or plastic sticks, string, thread, string, paper clips, cork, transparent plastic, markers, permanent markers, cleaning rag, scissors, hole puncher.

The fish:
 1. Draw the outline of the fish with markers on the plastic; if you make a mistake, you can do it with a rag.
 2. Paint the fish with the permanent markers and cut them out.
 3. Make a hole in the paper part so you can catch them.
 4. Cut the cork into rectangular shapes.
 5. Make a small cut in each cork to insert the fish.

The fishing rods:
 1. Tie the string thread to the end of each stick.
 2. Attach an open paper clip to the end of each thread.
 Fill the bucket with water. Put your fish in the water and you are ready to go fishing.
 If you write the numbers from 1 to 8 at the bottom of each stick, you can add up the numbers of the fish you have caught and the player with most points will be the winner.

week 25 Sincerity

 The upright will prosper, but those who sow trouble will reap it.
 God wants us to be honest, sincere, spontaneous and frank.

Children sometimes say:
 - I have had my mouth open so many times I know you had me not to take it to school.
What do we answer?
 No, you should have done what you were told, but it is good that you are able to say you are sorry.

A few minutes to think:
 Sincerity is an important attitude to have and we need to encourage children to be sincere.

Personal diary
Matthew 6:3
 Write and coloured sheets of paper, cardboard from a box, scissors, permanent marker, hole puncher, pencil, glue and some ribbon.

1. Cut two sides of the cardboard box the same size as the sheets of paper. They will be the covers.
 2. Place one cover on top and the other under the sheets of paper and punch the holes on one of the sides.
 3. Cut out two pieces of cloth. Rigor that the covers.
 4. Apply some glue to the covers and press them on the cloth. Fold the remaining cloth inside the covers.
 5. Line the inside of each cover with a coloured sheet of paper for a nice finishing touch.
 6. Place the ribbon through the holes and tie with a bow.
 7. Write MY DIARY on the top cover using a marker. On you can stick a photo with your name on the cover.

Your diary is a place where you can write down how you feel and what happens to you. It is a place where you can be alone and this will help you to learn about being sincere with others too.

 If you are sincere in your diary, if you tell you to remember what you are older for you, you will know when you were younger.

week 2 Joy

Psalm 122:1
 I love Jerusalem where they said to me: 'Let's go up to God's house!'

It is good to go to church; it is a place where we meet people, share our faith and think about what is happening in our lives.

Children sometimes say:
 - I got bored in church because I have to keep quiet and it all takes too long.
What do we answer?
 We go to church to praise God and to listen to Jesus' Word. We ought to be quiet.

A few minutes to think:
 This is a common complaint from our children; but, if you get them to participate in the liturgy - getting them to read or sing, helping them to give thanks and helping them to understand what is happening - then they are happier about going to church.

Listening game
Matthew 13:9
 Blessed are your eyes that see and your ears that hear.

1. Find three people to play this game.
 2. One person is a speaker, one is a listener and one is an observer.
 3. The speaker tells a story for two minutes and the listener listens.
 4. The listener cannot speak but can only say "yes" or "no" or "why".
 5. The observer makes sure that the speaker and the listener do what they are supposed to and keeps track of the time.

It is not as hard as you think!
Reflection:
 Just before lunch or supper if at home, or during a break at school, get everyone in the group to be absolutely quiet for a couple of minutes, thinking about something each one wants.
 When time is up, each person, child or adult, gets the chance to tell the others what he or she was thinking about, and everyone should listen to them. We all need to learn to listen and we all want to be listened to.

 Being quiet can teach how to listen and how to take time to think.
